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Guidelines for Submissions to the IACAPAP Bulletin

Thank you for considering the IACAPAP Bulletin for your article submission.

The IACAPAP Quarterly Bulletin publishes articles related to child and adolescent mental health for a global audience. Accepted articles are published on the IACAPAP website, distributed to a mailing list consisting of thousands of subscribers and shared on IACAPAP's social media outlets.

Here are the submission guidelines:

- Articles are generally about 500-1000 words in length. If you would like to submit something of a different length, please reach out to the editor in advance.
- Each article should clearly list the author(s) and their affiliation.
- Visuals (photos, diagrams, illustrations) are very important as part of an article submission. Each visual should be of high resolution and accompanied by a caption describing who/what the photo is about. Photo credits should be given when due.
- Please remember that the bulletin publishes news articles and is not a scientific publication. If you want to submit a scientific article, please consider IACAPAP's journal [Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Mental Health](#).
- If your article includes references, please use the [Vancouver style](#).
- We request that authors disclose any conflicts of interest they may think are relevant to their submission. For articles discussing any products (pharmaceuticals, devices etc) a conflict-of-interest statement is mandatory for a submission.
- We encourage prospective authors to review previous issues of the [Bulletin](#) to get a sense of the type of articles published.

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- AI cannot be an author and couldn't be used to generate the entire text. The author(s) voice needs to come through.
- Authors are fully responsible for all submitted content.
- AI assistance should be disclosed.
- AI may not be used to fabricate, falsify, or manipulate data.

Authors may use AI tools for purposes such as:

- language editing
- grammar and style improvement
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- translating text

Unacceptable AI use:

- Generating the entire text
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- Generating fictitious data or references, manipulate images or results

Authors remain fully responsible for the accuracy, originality, and scientific validity of all submitted work.
