Here are the submission guidelines:

- Articles are generally about 500-1000 words in length. If you would like to submit something of a different length, please reach out to the editor in advance.
- Each article should clearly list the author(s) and their affiliation.
- Visuals (photos, diagrams, illustrations) are very important as part of an article submission. Each visual should be of high resolution and accompanied by a caption describing who/what the photo is about. Photo credits should be given when due.
- Please remember that the bulletin publishes news articles and is not a scientific publication. If you want to submit a scientific article, please consider IACAPAP's journal [Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Mental Health](#).
- If your article includes references, please use the [Vancouver style](#).
- We request that authors disclose any conflicts of interest they may think are relevant to their submission. For articles discussing any products (pharmaceuticals, devices etc) a conflict-of-interest statement is mandatory for a submission.
- We encourage prospective authors to review previous issues of the [Bulletin](#) to get a sense of the type of articles published.
