INVITATION TO BID FOR IACAPAP CONGRESS 2026

We warmly encourage all proposals likely to promote child and adolescent mental health and attract professionals from all over the world.

Key Dates

- 30 April 2020 – letter of interest outlining broadly key information, e.g. the place, topic, or proposed dates (max. 2 pages)
- 30th June 2020 - deadline for receipt of bid
- 19th July 2020 – presentation of bids to the Executive Committee

Your letter of interest and full bid proposal should be sent to the IACAPAP administrator, Ms. Sue Wong (info@iacapap.org) by the respective deadlines. Please address the following points in the full proposal:

- location of the meeting (city, conference centre, hotels, airport location and main airlines serving the location)
- proposed dates, estimated weather conditions and coinciding local activities
- VISA requirements
- theme of the congress
- importance of the congress for local and regional development of child & adolescent psychiatry and mental health
- detailed information regarding the budget
 - based on projections of the number of attendees (1000, 1500, 2000)
 - with registration fees based on different scenarios. Please note that IACAPAP individual members should receive discounted registration
- please prepare your bid with following information in mind:
 - by 2026 IACAPAP may have a core PCO
 - The contract will be between IACAPAP and the full member organisation (national organisation). The national organisation will hold the financial responsibility for the congress, but will have a 50% profit sharing arrangement with IACAPAP
